


## Giving to the Friends of Summerhill

As you may know, we have received a local ward grant for £50,000 to carry out essential building works and the bowlers passed us £3,000 to cover initial running costs. This form sets out the costs of running the Club and asks for your help in meeting those costs.

## Ongoing Costs

The ongoing running costs of the Bowling Club are approximately £9,000 per year. This is comprised of:

Insurance	£1,000
Utilities and rates	£1,500
Building maintenance	£2,500
Cleaning	£2,000
Land maintenance/gardening	£1,000
Accounting, telephone, audit, stationery, fees	£1,000

*Please note that these costs exclude any capital expenditure or more substantial building projects, for which we will fundraise separately.*

As the Club becomes more established as a community asset, we may also look for a part time administrator to manage bookings, and deal with the ongoing administration of the Club. Costs associated with bookings (such as extra cleaning) are expected to be covered by rental income.

## How will these costs be met?

(i) We intend to actively promote the bowling Club as a venue for members and the broader community and this will generate rental income. To start with this income will be modest but will increase with time.


(ii) We will also be applying for funding from external grant-giving bodies later in the year - but given that competition for grants from these sources is intense, success cannot always be guaranteed.

(iii) We are asking you, our members, to contribute towards the running costs of the Club.
